

Pool Club Opens Tuesday 26th May

The PTA Pool Club enables Aldryngton families to make use of the school's outdoor heated swimming pool after school and during the holidays, providing not just swimming but also a social focus for both children and parents. This year's Pool club season starts on the Tuesday of half-

term, 26th May 2015 and runs through to Friday 4th September 2015. Only those Aldryngton children who are Pool Club members are allowed to use the Pool Club, so make sure your children don't miss out! Your support for the Pool Club is vital to the continued viability of the school pool. An online application form and payment mechanism are in the process of being set up on the PTA web page. Once all the details are finalised they will be uploaded onto the PTA web pages including Pool Club Rules, Operating Procedure and some Q&A's. Pool Club members undergo induction should resuscitation training and this year's training sessions are currently being organised for a Saturday and a weekday evening in May.



We held a very successful quiz on **Friday 13th March**, 12 teams took part

with around 70 parents, children, teachers and Governors helping to raise £500. A huge thank you to everyone who helped organise and run the event and to all the families that participated.

<u>Cake Sales:</u> Since the last PTA New, cake sales held in February and March have raised a further £192.75. Bringing a total so far this academic year of £585.00

<u>Discos/Parent Creche</u>: Autumn and Winter discos raised £814 and the February bar generated an extra income of £170, October bar raised £150.

<u>2nd Hand Uniform Sales</u>: The February sale raised £42.60 and the March sale raised £94. All sales combined since they began have generated in excess of £1000!


