payable to Aldryngton School PTA please. To secure your place(s) you must return your order form and payment to the PTA post box in the office foyer no later than Wednesday 21st February.

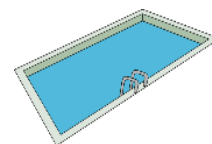

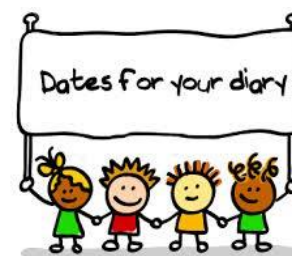
March to raise funds for the PTA. This scheme is designed to help schools to raise funds and to help the environment by diverting discarded but reusable textiles away from

For example, American Dollars, Euros, German Marks, Spanish Pesetas, old UK shillings, old 50p coins and old £1 coins. The collection bucket will be situated in the school office foyer. The bucket will be there all year so keep those old/unwanted coins coming in. Once the bucket is full, the PTA will send it to www.cash4coins.co.uk who will exchange it into cash.
