Addendum to the school's behaviour policy - CV 19 June 2020



The following addendum is to ensure all adults and children are kept safe in school to limit the spread of COVID-19.

Incidents of unsafe, inappropriate behaviour will be referred to a senior member of staff and a decision taken on an appropriate sanction.

Arrival and departure

- Pupils are to arrive at the allotted time, and make their way directly to their assembly point observing social distancing at all times.
- When leaving the school site, pupils are again to make their way directly off-site observing social distancing.

Hygiene

- Pupils are to observe school instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitizing.
- Pupils are to adopt the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' process of dealing with sneezes and to cough into the crook of their arms.
- Pupils are to tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus / feel unwell.
- Pupils are not to share any equipment or other items including drinking bottles.
- Pupils MUST wash their hands after every visit to the toilet.
- Pupils must flush the toilet after use and dispose of paper towels in the bins provided.

Moving around school

- All site users are to walk down corridors on the left-hand side.
- Outdoor play equipment is out of bounds at all times.
- When required to queue, pupils are to use the distance markers provided

Staying safe - general

- Pupils are to remain in their Bubble throughout the school day. They are not to enter areas occupied by pupils in another Bubble.
- Pupils are to follow instructions of all staff at all times.
- Pupils are to be respectful of others to support mental health and wellbeing of our school community.
- Pupils are required to look after their belongings making sure they do not become hazards for others.

Inappropriate behaviour - sanctions and rewards

- Deliberate coughing or spitting at or towards any other person will not be tolerated and will result in the child being isolated / sent home.
- Appropriate use of the internet / remote learning rules apply at all times.
- The school has trained staff to apply positive handling techniques (Team Teach) in circumstances where a pupil has lost the ability to make safe behaviour choices for themselves and others. This is rarely used. However due to the 2m social distancing rule, this can no longer be used. If Team Teach is required, parents will be contacted immediately.
- The usual reward systems will continue to apply as before, with modifications as necessary.
